of the mortality of Man do make & declare this
last Will & Testament in manner & form
following to wit

First I give to my beloved Sister Lucy Miles (or 12)
present using some Horse together with my saddle
to him and his heirs forever - I also give to
my beloved Brother Arnold sitting the sum of Five
dollars in cash to him & his heirs forever & also
to my beloved Brother I give make & constitute
the sum of Five dollars cash to him & his heirs
forever 4th I give to my beloved Sister Lucy
Miles one Habit dress of Lustring with Acco-
panying the same 5th I give to my beloved Sister
Lucy Miles one Habit dress of Lustring with Acco-
panying the same to her & her heirs forever
6th I give to my beloved Brothers & Sisters Mary
Miles Ransom & Alice Mary Brown Miles
& Lucy & Alice all the balance of my
estate both real & personal (after discharging
my Just Debts) to be Equally divided
according to Law equity & Justice among
the children of them theirs forever & I do hereby
constitute & appoint my
beloved Brother Miles & Alice my true & lawful
executors to execute my last Will &

Testament I testimony whereof have been
wrote set my hand & seal this twenty
second day of October and in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred

and fourteen
