she has already got. I do also give and
bequeath to my Youngest daughter Nancy
One negro girl named Dicy to be left
to her at her mothers death. the first
living child that the said negro girl
bears at one year old I Give to my
James Bryant above mentioned. And
next ~~my~~ living child at ~~the~~
my above mentioned daughter.

Also I give and bequeath to my son &
Daughter Mary Simmons the sum of
One dollar and fifty cents. Also I give to
my daughter Elizabeth Bryant the sum of
One dollar and fifty cents. And lastly as to
all the rest residue & remainder of my
personal estate goods and chattels of
whatsoever kind and nature I give
and bequeath the same to my said beloved
wife Elizabeth Bryant whom I appoint
executrix and John A. Dair executor of this
my last will and testament hereby
revoking all former wills by me made
