I *Elizabeth Hemphill* of the County of Morgan & State of Georgia being of sound mind and sane memory knowing the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death and being desirous to dispose of the property with which Providence has blessed me do make this my last Will and testament. In the first place I give and bequeath unto my three beloved sons *William, Thompson, & Marcus Hemphill* four negroes to wit *Jacob, Charles, Esther* and her son *Lymus* together with their increase to be equally divided between my said sons *William, Thompson, & Marcus Hemphill* according to valuation.

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my beloved son *Marcus Hemphill* in trust, for the use and benefit of my beloved wife daughter *Mary Woolbright* the sum of three hundred dollars, with which I desire my said son *Marcus Hemphill* to purchase a negro girl, for the maintenance and support of my said daughter *Mary Woolbright* during the term of her natural life; then my will is, that the said money, with the interest of any shall be paid by my said son *Marcus* and the proceeds equally divided between my aforesaid sons *William, Thompson, and Marcus Hemphill*.

Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my beloved sons *William, Thompson, and Marcus Hemphill* to be equally divided between them; all the residue of my estate, both real and personal, consisting of *Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep, money, notes &c.*

Fourthly I do hereby make Ordain, constitute and appoint my beloved son *Marcus Hemphill* Executor of this my last Will and testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me at any time heretofore made and do declare this my last Will and testament. In Witness whereof I the said *Elizabeth Hemphill* have hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day of February 1835 Signed sealed published and declared by the above named *Elizabeth Hemphill* as her last Will and testament in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses thereto in the presence of the said testator and in the presence of each other

Item 1st I desire my Executors hereafter named to pay all my just debts without the sale of property if there be assets enough on hand with the demands and to do the same

Item 2nd I give unto my beloved wife *Elizabeth Chaffin* for the use benefit education & maintenance of my Children the use & control of all my estate both real and personal for her to manage as she may think best for the best interest of my Children during her life or Widowhood; but in the event of her marriage my will is that there be an equal distribution of the property and increase among her & all my Children in the event of her death before marriage my Will is that there be an equal distribution among all my Children then in life or then living & deceased

Item 3rd I appoint my beloved wife *Elizabeth* Executrix and my friends *Matthew Mayne* & *John Nolan* my Executors to carry into effect this my Will

Item 4th Lastly I give and bequeath my soul to God who gave it & desire my body be buried in a Christian like manner In testimony whereof I the said *Samuel Chaffin* have set my hand this Eleventh day of July Eight hundred and thirty six Signed in presence of *Elizabeth Hubbard*
