

Will of Gannaway Malcom, Morgan Co. Will Book  
1830-1860

Georgia Morgan Co.

I, Gannaway Malcom of the County and state aforesaid, being of sick body but of sound mind and memory do here by make this my last will and testament as follows:

- 1st. It is my will that all my just debts be paid.
- 2nd. It is my will that all my property both real and personal belonging to my estate be disposed as follows:
- 3rd. It is my will that my beloved wife, Rebecca Malcom hold my land and the proceeds thereof until my daughter, Rebecca, comes of age or my wife lives a lifetime, also, all the negro property except what I now give to my children: W. Arnold McIlbary, Fanny and Louiza provided there is money sufficient to pay my debts, if not she must be sold and Fanny's child Sela & McIlbary's child, Martha. The above names property to remain in the hands of my wife for the maintaining and educating of my minor children.
- 4th. I give to my son, John Malcom, a negro boy named, Hampton.
- 5th. I give to my daughter Charity, one negro boy, Judge.
- 6th. I give to my son, Wilson Malcom, one negro boy, Green.
- 7th. I give to my daughter Mary ann Malcom, one negro boy, Seabron.
- 8th. I give to my daughter Sarah Malcom, when of age five hundred dollars worth of property of my estate in the hands of my executors.
- 9th. I give to my daughter, Juda Malcom, when of age, five hundred dollars worth of property as above mentioned.
- 10th. I give to my daughter, Rebecka Malcom when of age, five hundred dollars worth of property as above.
- 11th. I give to my daughter Elizabeth Williams the land she now lives on and then the other effects that I consider worth to her five hundred dollars.
- 12th. I give to my daughter Permellia Blasingame, land and other effects that I consider worth five hundred dollars.
- 13th. I have given to my son Barnet Malcom, five hundred dollars worth of property, land and other effects.
- 14th. It is my will that my son John and Wilson have my land equally, when my youngest child comes of age, the land I now live on.
- 15th. It is my will after the death of my wife Rebecka Malcom and the foregoing distribution: the remains of my property to be equally divided amongst all my children. Barnet, John, Willson, Permellia, Elizabeth, Charity, Maryann, Sarah, Juda, Rebecka.
- 16th. I appoint my sons, Barnet, John and Wilson Malcom my executors of this my last will and testament.
