and Testament

First I commend my soul to God who gave it hoping for
mercy through Jesus Christ and my body I commend
the same to be decently buried at the discretion of my friends
and Executors

Secondly and as for such property as the Lord has
blessed me with I dispose of in the following manner
1st as for my two sons James and John they have received
what I intended for them out of my Estate

2^{ndly} I Give and bequeath to my daughter Frances one
cow and calf with what she has already received (to wit)
one feather bed and furniture one Horse and saddle one
coat and one pot &c

3^{rdly} I bequeath to my son William one cow and calf
one saddle one cow and calf

4^{thly} I Give and bequeath to my son Peter one bay horse
colt one mans saddle also one cow and calf at his
coming of age or Marriage

5^{thly} I Give and bequeath to my son Robert one cow
one horse colt a mans saddle to be raised out of my property
also one cow and calf at his coming of age or Marriage

6^{thly} I Give and bequeath to my son Moses one horse colt
and saddle to be raised out of my property also one
cow and calf at his coming of age or Marriage

7th I Give and bequeath my daughter Betsey one feather bed
and furniture and one cow and calf

8^{thly} I Give and bequeath to my two daughters Polly and
Anne each one feather bed and furniture and one cow and calf

9^{thly} It is my will and desire that one yellow Girl named Lucy
and as much of my property be sold as will discharge my
debts and give my two youngest daughters Polly and
Anne one years schooling at least

10^{thly} I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary 500
acres of land with the premises where I live with the premises

Thereof one bay in are called pilot one small horse called
Jack one feather bed and furniture one Roman summer
bed one chest two wheels and bands all the cupboard
and kitchen furniture one Loom and Gen two pair of
horse gear with as many of the plantation tools as
she has need of and all the cattle except them a bone
mentioned also the hogs also one Negro woman named
Patty to be for her use and the support of her
and the children as long as she lives, and at her
death all to be equally divided between those my
children hereafter mentioned it is my will that
the waggon and hind gear be for the benefit of
my wife and sons at large also it is my will
that my and children have free recourse to my
Book also any part of the stock to be disposed
of if need be to be by the consent of my Executor
hereafter named It is also my will and desire
that the balance of my Land be for the
benefit of my four sons (to wit) William
Peter Robert and Moses to live on or till
untill the death of my wife and it is my will
and desire that all the Land and my wife's
part at her death be sold and each of my
children viz William Peter Robert Moses
Betsey Polley and Anne have an equal share
with each other in

lastly I appoint my beloved wife Executrix
and my son William Executor of this my last
will and testament and I do hereby disallow
and revoke all other wills testaments and Executors
