

In the name of God Amen I John
Davis of the County of Morgan and State of
Georgia being sick and in a low condition
of mind and perfect memory and
calling to mind the mortality of man I do in the
first place resign my soul to God that a vicar
and my body to be decently buried at the discretion
of my Executors As to my temporal Estate I
dispose of it the following manner (Wiz)
Item 1 I give to my son Jonathan Davis one hun-
dred and fifty Acres of Land lying on the Western
Side of the Salt that I now live on also twenty head
of hogs such as will be of the most benefit also
50 or head of sheep such as is his choice also
one cow horse & a barrel mare with a blaze
I also give of Beds bedsteads & furniture
also three Cows and a long Chain of the stock
It is also my will that my son Jonathan is to take
care of his mother until her death
Item 2 I give to my son David Davis the balance
of the lot of Land I now live on also one
Cow and eight sheep also one cow & calf also
one bedstead Bed and furniture with all the
property that he has received —

Item 3 I give my daughter Nancy Warren two
sheep and one heifer yearling together with
the property she has received in —

Item 4 I give to my son George Davis two sheep
together with the property he has received —

Item 5 I give to my daughter Elizabeth the bed
bedstead and furniture which she calls her
own one side saddle and one pair of shoes

27th year also one trunk one table one
pair of flat Iron also such Crochery Ma-
a; the Coll her son also one Cotton Wheel
Charley - Item 6th I give to my Daughter Mary
one Curtain beasted bed & furniture also
one Pithy Car and herse yearlin also one Chest
Item 7th I give to my son James Davis two Hogs also
one beasted bed & furniture with all the property
he has Recd - Item 8th I give to my son Breckin
Davis two Sheep with all the property that he
has Recd - Item 9th I give to my two William
& Martin Davis all the property that they have Recd
Item 10th I also wish my beloved Wife Mary Davis
to be & do hereby appoint her to be my sole
executrix and to take and make use of all
my notes & Ccct to pay all just debts that I am
owing this being my last Will and testament
I do hereby revoke all former Wills by me
made - In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand this 27th day of Sept 1813.

Morgan County In the name of God
I, Amos S. Peter Snelling
of the state and County of Morgan being weak &
feeble in body but of sound and disposing memory
do make and decree this my last will and testament
in manner and form following (Viz),
I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Mother Sally Snelling Widow of Alexander
Snelling late of the state of Virginia and County
of Chesterfield the sum of Fifty Dollars and
also a parcel of plants which I have now on
the plantation whereon she resides, which said
plants is to be applied to the use of Repairing or
building on said plantation at her discretion
I also bequeath unto my Mother one feather bed
now in the state of Virginia left me by my
Father for and during her natural life and
at her death I give the said bed & furniture
to my Nephew Benjamin LaPrade his heirs &
assigns forever Also to my Will & desire that
my Mother as aforesaid remain in the peaceful
possession & enjoyment of the Lands and
