I give and bequeath to my beloved son David Malcom, two negroes, namely: 3rd. Jack and Henry.

I give and bequeath to my beloved son, Gannaway Malcom, Two negroes, Lth.

namely: Charles and Jobe.

I give and bequeath to my beloved son, John Malcom, two negroes, namely: 5th. Peter and Sam.

I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter, Sally Adcock, formerly Sally 6th. Malcom, one dollar ready money.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved son, James Malcom, two negroes, namely 7th. Dave and George.

8th. I give and bequeath unto my beloved son, George W. Malcom, two negroes,

namely: Paw and Sarah.

9th. I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter, Nancy Robertson, formerly Nancy Malcom, four negroes namely Mariah, Harriett, Reuben and Israel, also two hundred dollars in money.

10th. I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Anna Herndon, formerly Anna Malcom, one dollar ready money.

llth. My will and desire is that my five sons, to wit: David Malcom, Canaway Malcom, John Malcom, James Malcom and George W. Malcom have all my land and that my estate be equally divided between them. I do hereby constitute and appoint as my executors to this my last will and testament, David Malcom and Gannaway Malcom.

12th, My will and desire is that my executors above mentioned do carry this my last will and testament into effect given under my hand and seal this 12th
