and Testament that is to say

First It is my will and desire that all my Just debts  
be paid Readly I give and bequeath unto my  
beloved wife Agathy Patillo the three following  
named Negro Slaves to wit, Sam Lucy and Bonita  
to have the said three negro Slaves as her own  
right and property and to have disposition thereof  
as she may think proper I further give to my  
said wife Agathy all the Person Right and title  
of that part of the Estate of Jacob Brown  
deceased to which she was by law entitled  
previous to my intermarriage with the said  
Agathy -

Secondly It is my will and desire that all the  
balance of my Estate both Real and personal  
be Equally divided between (to wit) John Patillo  
James Patillo Elizabeth Hanson (formerly Elizabeth  
Patillo) William Patillo Mary Patillo Henry  
Patillo Sarah Patillo Rebecca Patillo Lewis  
Patillo Sally Patillo and David Patillo

Fourthly and lastly I have by Certificate twice and approved  
my Sons John Patillo and James Patillo and my  
wife Agathy Patillo as Executors of this my  
last Will and Testament here by. Revoked  
all former Will and testaments by me made  
In testimony whereof I have hereunto
