Secondly that after my just debts being
paid I give & bequeath all my estate goods
or Chattels Real or personal that I am
now in possession of or may hereafter be in
possession of before my decease, to my wife
Elizabeth Wootan, during her natural life.
And after the decease of my wife Elizabeth it
is my will & desire & I do hereby give & bequeath
all my Estate that I am now in or may here
after be in possession of as lands & tenements
goods & Chattels rights & credits to my five
children namely John Wootan Phebe a Cassey
& my sole Elizabeth Whately & Anna Mary
to be equally divided amongst them. I do
also nominate & appoint John Cole Executor &
Elizabeth Wootan my wife Exec^{tr} to this my last
Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 4th of February
1810.
