myself that I should make a disposition of
the property with which a kind Providence
has blessed me do therefore make this my last
will and testament hereby revoking all others
hereinafter made by me,

1. Item I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and Christian like manner
suitable to my circumstances in life. My
soul I trust shall return to rest with
god who gave it for eternal salva-
tion through the merits and atonement
of the blessed saviour.

2. Item I desire and direct that all my just
debts be paid by my executors herein after
appointed without delay.

3. Item I give and bequeath unto my son
John my negro boy Alfred about thirteen years
old, said boy being now in possession of said
master and also I give and bequeath unto
him all that he has ever received from
me in my power to keep forever.

4. Item I give and bequeath unto my son John
my negro boy Sidney about ten years old.
said boy being now in possession of said
master and also I give and bequeath unto him
all that he has ever received from me in my
power to keep forever.

5th Item. I give and bequeath to my son Louis Willis, my negro boy John Wilson about fifteen years old who is now in possession of my son Louis W. and also I give and bequeath unto him all that he has ever received from me in any manner to keep forever.

6th Item, I give and bequeath to the lawful heirs of my Daughter Anna St. my negro girl Jane about twelve years old said girl being now in possession of Randolph McCallum to keep forever and I appoint my Son in law Randolph McCallum trustee for said heirs of said property together with what other effects I may have in office will be said heirs by his giving security for the forth coming of the same when said heirs come of age.

7th Item. The residue of my property both real and personal wherever and whatever it may be I desire and direct that it be sold by my executors and the effects of the same to be equally divided between my lawful heirs.

8th Item, I hereby constitute and appoint my sons Joseph Humphreys & David W. Humphreys executors of this my last will & testament.
