Item first. I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife

half lot of land on which the house is built to be taken
off of said half lot of land so as to include the house and
extend along the line of Robert M. Camps untill it joins
A. M. Durners Murray County Wills 1840-1872
then to revert to my son Albert M. Thee and I also
will to my loving wife my Oldest mare all my household
furniture two Cows and enough of hogs to raise her meat
the balance of my stock I want sold and the proceeds divided
equally among my Children

Item 2nd I will and bequeath unto my son Albert S
M. Thee my half lot of land known as the east half of lot
(282) two hundred and eighty two in the ninth district and third
Section

Item 3rd I will and bequeath unto my son Sarken and
and James M. M. Thee my lot of land known as lot (283)
two hundred and ninety five in the (8th) ninth district and
third (3) Section. and also the remaining two thirds of the half
lot or eighty of land on which I live after taking off one
third for my wife as above described

Item 4th I will and bequeath my two lots of land on Kelly
Creek known as lots (311 and 312) three hundred and eleven and
three hundred and twelve in the ninth (7) district and 3rd third

Section to my son Burton M. Ghee lawful heirs to be divided
equally among them

Item 5th I also will and bequeath unto my Grand son Isaac M.
Ghee my young mare and a bridle and saddle to be worth
twenty dollars and it is also my wish that he shall stay with
the family and have land to work until he shall become of age
or twenty one years old if he shall choose to do so. and have two Cows
