it my duty to make such disposition as
I think proper with the property with
which a kind providence has blessed
me, do make and ordain this my last
Will and Testament hereby revoking all
other Will by me made at any time hereafter.

First - I will and bequeath my negro girl
Lucinda now about nine years old with
her increase to my much esteemed Brother
William M. McEntire.

Second I will and bequeath the following
negroes, George aged about five years
Sandy aged twelve years, Sarah aged thirteen
years and John aged eight years with
their increase to my esteemed Brother
James L. McEntire his heirs & assigns.

Third I will and bequeath one undivided
half of four hundred and eighty acres of
Land it being Lots No 263, 264 & 277 in
the Tenth District and 3rd Section of Murray
County in said State, One negro woman
named Moriah supposed now to be 55
years of age and one negro boy named
Munaphy now about seven years of age
to my much esteemed Nephew John C.
McEntire.
