in the third Item thus bequeathed unto my wife Mary Jane
during her natural lifetime or widowhood at the natural
death or Marriage of my said wife. then shall the above num
ed Negro girl Arny together with all her natural increase
be the right and property of the above named John M. Reuben
B. and Charles J. my my three youngest Son to have and
to possess from day forward

5th Item the residue of my property both real and personal where
ever and whatever it may be I desire to be sold and my last debt
paid out of the proceeds and if there shall any remain I desire
that such remainder be equally divided between my wife and
all my Children that is each one having and equal part or
share

6th Item I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved Son
William B. Wilkinson Executor of this my last will and testament
this the 2nd of July 1857
