Item 2nd I will and bequeath to my beloved daughters Elizabeth Neal and Sarah M. Williams all of my land estate known as lot of land No 5 in the 3rd Section and 8th District of said County of Murray and in the event of said Sarah and Elizabeth becoming dissatisfied and not wishing to live longer on the land and both of them to go to their father, said land to be sold and the proceeds divided equally between said daughters and my beloved son Rufus Neal seeing that my daughter Elizabeth Neal shall have seventy five dollars more to her share than Sarah M. Williams or Rufus Neal.

Item 3rd I will and bequeath to my daughter Alice Neal and Robert Berry the sum of five dollars each to come out of the proceeds of a sale of the land if sold as above provided for in Item 2nd.

Item 4th I hereby name and appoint as the Executor of this my last will and Testament to see that its provisions are fully carried out James Rufus Neal who is named in Item 2nd of the said will as Rufus Neal.
