as it pleaseth God to bless me with I give and bequeath
the same in manner following that is to say I bequeath to my
Daughter Elizabeth One Certain dark bay Colt about
two years old & two Cows & calves and One bed and
Furniture and to have out of the proceeds of my perso-
nal Effects Twenty Dollars to purchase her a Saddle And I bequeath to my daughter Margaret
Malinda One Cow and Calf And I bequeath to be
my son Jackson Boyd One Cow and Calf and
of the balance of my personal effects I bequeath One
Third thereof to my daughter Margaret during
her natural life and after paying my funeral expen-
ses and just debts I bequeath the remainder of my
personal effects to my lawful heirs And of my real
Estate I bequeath all my lands and plantations
with all the appertinances there to belonging to my
son Jackson Boyd with this reserve that my
beloved wife Margaret is to at her pleasure keep
possession of the Houses and lots and a suffici-
ent quantity of the cleared land to make a
Support for my daughter Elizabeth until she becom-
es of age or Marries and a sufficient support
for herself during her natural life that is of the
lands on the north west side of the Cone-sauga
River Now the lands and improvements on the
South east side of the Cone-sauga I bequeath to
two of my sons William Sloan and Ellis Sloan
with this reserve that for the support of my
beloved wife during her natural life

The Field And I request my Executors herein after
named to examine the last Mentioned bequeathed
lands and divide it equal between William Sloan
and Ellis Sloan And I further will to my wife
Margaret The present crop that is now growing on
my place and one sorrel blazed faced man
about ten or twelve years old And lastly I do
hereby Constitute and appoint two of my sons
Archibald Sloan and Jackson T. Sloan
Executors of this my last will and Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this the 30th day of May in the Year of
Our Lord One Thousand eight hundred & forty
five Signed Sealed published and declared to
be the last will and Testament of the above named
Robert Sloan
