that I have to die do make this my last will and testament
First I appoint my Wife Francis Bailey and Benjamin
W. Cash my executors to this my last will and testament
Secondly I give and bequeath unto my wife Francis Bailey
all my Property notes Accounts &c that I may have received
of all my death during her natural life to enable her
to raise my young Children and for her own Support
Thirdly I leave and bequeath that all my estate that
remains after my Wife's death shall be regularly divided
among my Children Martha Child Sarah Child &c
