

Mrs. Adela E. Huff Will

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State of Georgia Muscogee County

I, Adela E. Huff of the State and County aforesaid, knowing the uncertainty of life, and the certainty of death, do make, ordain, publish and declare, this my last will and testament

I give unto P. H. Alston, all my property, goods, land, money and effects of every description that I may die possessed of; to have and to hold the said effects as Trustee for my son Donaldson Huff. That the said P. H. Alston shall use said effects to the best of his knowledge, for the advantage of said Donaldson Huff, until said Huff shall have arrived at the age of twenty one years. And furthermore, the said P. H. Alston Trustee shall in his discretion use such sum or sums, arising alone from the interest he may receive from such effects for the use of my son Donaldson Huff.

I desire and direct that the said P. H. Alston shall not be required to give bond for the faithful execution of this my last will and testament, nor shall he be required to make any returns to any Court or Courts whatsoever.

In testimony whereof I the said Adela E. Huff after this my last will and testament subscribe my name and affix my seals this the Fifth day of August in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and Seventy Five
