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State of Georgia Muscogee County

I, Arminious Wright of said State & County being of sound & disposing mind & memory, do make publish & declare this my last will & testament in manner following.

- Item 1st The lot or parcel of land in the City of Columbus County of Muscogee & State of Georgia belonging to my wife Sarah Amelia Wright & which she received from her father, having been built upon & improved with funds belonging to us jointly. She is to have as of her own absolute Estate. I hereby giving & bequeathing unto her all interest title or Estate I have in the same
- Item 2^d All the remainder of my property real & personal of Every description & kind it is my will shall be equally divided between my wife and children, share & share alike
- Item 3^d It is my will that my wife Sarah Amelia Wright shall be Executrix of this my last will & testament & that she be also Guardian of my minor children.
