In the name of God Amen.

I Elizabeth C. Court of the City of Columbus, in the County of Muscogee and State of Georgia, being of sound mind and memory, and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life, do therefore make Ordain, publish and declare this to be my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time heretofore made.

I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sarah C. Hawks, Heiress of Rev. H. H. Hawks, the tract or parcel of Land in the City of Columbus aforesaid purchased by me from Louis Haiman, known as Lot Number One Hundred & Twenty Eight (128) with all the rights, Members and Appurtenances to said Lot in any Appurtenances and Belongings, to have and to hold the same to her the said Sarah C. her Executors, Administrators and assigns forever.

I make, constitute and appoint my Grand son William H. Hawks to be the Executor of this my last will and Testament. I so witness when I have hereunto subscribed my hand and affixed my seal this 22nd day of June in the year One thousand Eight Hundred and six.
