

Heiman Flirsch's Will

I, Heiman Flirsch, residing in the State and County aforesaid, being in sound mind and memory, but knowing the uncertainty of human life, do hereby make, publish and declare the following as my last will and testament -

1st It is my will and I do direct that all my just debts shall be paid out of the monies collected and effects belonging to my Estate -

2^d Having full confidence in the judgment, prudence and discretion of my wife Rosa Lewin Flirsch, of said State and County aforesaid, I do hereby constitute and appoint her as sole Executor of this my last will and testament, and I do hereby give her full power and authority to manage my Estate in such a manner as shall be in her judgment to the best interest to my Estate - She shall have full power to sell any of my property, either real or personal belonging to my Estate, and it is my will that my wife Rosa Lewin Flirsch shall exercise this power of her own will and judgment during her life and her own benefit -

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my name and seal this the 5th day of March A. D. 1860.
