I Priscilla Ramsey of said county being advanced in
years but in Ordinary health and of sound and disposing mind
and memory and being desirous of making a disposition of such
property as I may be seized & possessed of do make ordain
publish & declare this my last will & testament in manner
following that is to say

First

It is my desire that my executor hereinafter named so soon
as he thinks best for the interest of my estate shall sell at
public or private sale and upon such terms as in his

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opinion may most conduce to the interest of my estate I hereby give & bequeath by real or personal of which I may die seized & possessed and also collect all such debts as may be due me or to be due me after my death arising from any source whatever

Secondly After my just debts funeral expenses & costs of executing this will are paid I desire that my executor hereinafter named shall receive three hundred dollars and one ninth part of the balance of my estate

Annually upon the following uses limitations & trusts that is to say to permit my beloved daughter Eliza & Lively to have possession and enjoy the same for her sole & separate use free from the debts or liabilities of her present husband or any future husband she may hereafter have for & during the term of her natural life And in trust further upon the death of said Eliza & Lively to divide said three hundred dollars & said ninth part of the balance of my estate equally between such children as the said Eliza & may have surviving her at her death the child or children of a deceased child to represent their deceased parent and take the share he or she would have been entitled to if living at the death of said Eliza &

Thirdly I give the one ninth part of the aforesaid balance of my said estate to my son Randolph B Ramsay

Fourthly I give the one ninth part of the said balance of my said estate to my daughter Selina Jones wife of Samuel Jones

Fifthly I give the one ninth part of the said balance of my said estate to my son Elbert B Ramsay One ninth part thereof to Susan Edmondson wife of James Edmondson who is my daughter One ninth part thereof to Allen C Ramsay my son One ninth thereof to my son James W Ramsay One ninth thereof to my daughter Nancy Peters wife of Doct Middleton Peters And the remaining ninth part thereof to the children of my deceased daughter Mary Cartledge

Sixthly Should either of my said children die before my death the child or children of such deceased child shall take the share of their deceased parent but should either of my aforesaid children die before I do leaving no child or children surviving them at their death then it is my desire that the share of such deceased child shall be equally divided between their surviving brothers & sisters the share of said Eliza & Lively therein to be held by my said executor under the same uses trusts & limitations as is set forth in the second item of this my will

Lastly I do appoint George W Lively my son in law the executor of this my last will & testament expressly desiring expressly desiring that no bond should be required of him or said executor or as trustee aforesaid as I have implicit confidence that he will faithfully discharge the duties of said trusts
