

R. W. B. Muuro's Will

Muscogee County, Georgia Wills, Book C, 1875-1891

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I R. W. B. Muuro of the County of Muscogee and State of Georgia do make and publish this as my last Will and Testament.

- Item 1 I hereby direct that whatsoever of real and personal property I may die seized and possessed of shall remain together, and be held and managed by my Executrix and Executor for the benefit & support of my wife Mrs Sarah Muuro my daughter Miss Julia W. Muuro and my sons Samuel W. and Marks H. Muuro.
- Item 2 The property thus left and held I direct shall not be divided or disposed of in any manner whatever except by the consent of my said wife Mrs Sarah Muuro; who however is to have the right to make such gift as in her judgment she may think proper and feel able to donate to either of my children named or to Richard Jones, Charles W. or Sarah Anna Dean.
- Item 3 All the said estate shall continue undivided during the natural life of my said wife, and at her death whatever she may not have donated as before provided for, shall be subject to disposition by her, by will to our children and in the event she shall fail to dispose of it by will, then the same shall be divided between the children equally, having due regard to any advances made to either of them before the said division.
- Item 4 I hereby direct that Mrs Sarah Muuro and my Son Samuel W. Muuro do execute and carry out this my last Will and Testament and they be not required to make any Returns to the Ordinary of the County.
