State of Georgia I Sarah Phelps of the city of Co-
 muscogee County & State aforesaid be-
 ing of advanced age feeble in health but of sound mind and
 disposing memory knowing the uncertainty of life & certainty
 of death and wishing to dispose of the property that a kind Pro-
 vidence has been pleased to bless do hereby make this my last
 will & testament hereby revoking & annulling all other wills
 heretofore made by me

Item 1st I will & bequeath my soul to God who gave it & who I
 have endeavored to serve for many years And after
 death I direct that my body shall be buried in a decent
 and christianlike manner suitable to my circumstances in
 life

Item 2nd I will & desire that my executor hereinafter named shall pay
 all of my just debts as soon as he gets that amount of money
 in hand I desire that my executor shall utter out the same
 and let that I now occupy either privately or at public auc-
 tion as he may deem most to the interest of my estate and
 first to pay off from the money divided therefrom my out-
 stances for the same and the balance if any to my estate

Item 3rd I will & bequeath to my beloved daughter Jane Francis the
 the same one set of knives & forks one half of the crockery
 ware one half the kitchen furniture one large bed mattress
 bolster & pillows one clock one settee one set of curtains the

Item 3rd new set of castors & one Willow Rocking Chair
 I give & bequeath to my beloved son David K Phelps one set of knives & forks one bed bedstead & mattress bolster & pillows one willow chair half the crockery & crockery utensils one castor one set of curtains

Item 4th I will & bequeath to my beloved grandson Charles S Daniel all my Silver Spoons French Bedstead Bed & mattress Mattresses Indent White Counterpane Bolster & Pillows Large Rocking chair Images on the mantle piece Gold Watch - David K Phelps is to keep the Watch until until Charles arrives at the age of sixteen years, and then to give it to him In case of the death of David then his Aunt Jane H Bittmore to keep it until Charles is sixteen years of age If Charles should die before he arrives at sixteen years of age then David is to keep the watch also one marble top Bureau one Wash Stand one work Table all the gold & silver coin that I have the cows & all the balance of my Estate of whatever kind or nature to be sold & the proceeds thereof to be paid to the Guardian hereinafter appointed by me & to be managed by said Guardian for the best interest of my said Grand son Charles S Daniel and in the event that my said grand son should die before he is of age it is my will & desire that the property herein willed to my grand son shall be used for his support and education It is further my will & desire that my friend Joseph H Lee should take charge of the property herein willed to & be the guardian of my grand son Charles S Daniel

Item 5th I hereby nominate and appoint my friend William H Hughes executor of this my last will & testament this 11th day of December 1863

 to my mother which is about forty feet more or less on the
 back part of said lot fronting on Chapel St.

4th I will & bequeath to my beloved wife a house & lot
 on Grant St in the city of Columbus being a part of lot num-
 ber (86) meaning the income arising from the same during her
 natural life Also the income of one half of the house & lot number
 two hundred & fifty (250) situated on Ogilthorpe St that being
 my interest in the same during her natural life

5th I will & bequeath to my sister Ann two hundred and
