On the 11th day of December 1862 in open Court came William A Bedell & B H Mc Daniel who being duly sworn on oath say that they were present when Savinia A Fox published and declared the foregoing writing to be her last will and testament that at the time of said publishing said Savinia A Fox was of sound mind and disposing memory that so far as witnessing or know or believe she did it voluntarily without any undue influence or compulsion that said Savinia A Fox signed the same in the presence of deponents & Porter Ingram who at the request of said testatrix signed their names as witnesses in her presence and in the presence of each other W A Bedell

Thomas Sloan's Will

I Thomas Sloan of the county of Muscogee State of Georgia do make certain declare & publish this my last will & testament

Item 1st I will that all my debts be paid as soon as they conveniently can be

Item 2^d I give & bequeath all my property of a balance kind or nature to my father
Abner C Sloan

Item 3^d I appoint my father & my friend Judge M J Wellborn of Columbus Georgia my executors & empower them or either of them to wind up my estate in any way they think best I give them full power to sell, barter, exchange or transfer any of my property & to compound any of my claims And if Judge Wellborn should be unwilling to qualify I request that he give my father all the assistance & information he can which will enable him to wind up my estate properly

In witness of all which I have hereunto set my hand & seal on this 17th day of June A D 1862

Love M Gager's Will.

Georgia Muscogee County - I Love M Gager of Columbus in said State & County being full in body but of sound mind & disposing memory do make publish & declare this to be my last will & testament

Item 1.

I give bequeath & devise to my friend Charles W Chapman the lot which I own in the city of Columbus being part of lot No. 565 the same deeded to me by J G Thurston with all the appurtenances thereto belonging together with all the property of which I may die possessed Subject however to the following trusts After the payment of funeral expenses and any debts I may owe at the time of my death said property to be held for the use & benefit of my son George E Gager not subject to the debts contracts or liabilities of said George E but said George E to have & enjoy the use benefit & occupancy thereof And provided further that said property may be sold & conveyed & the proceeds re-invested or exchanged for other property by said Thurston or his successors in trust by & with the written consent of said trustee the trust And provided that if I shall ever become necessary to change the trustee as herein provided for or a vacancy in said trust shall occur my said son George E shall have power to select another with the same powers & privileges And provided further my said son shall have the right to dispose of said property or that which may be acquired therefrom or in lieu thereof by testament

Item 2.

I nominate & appoint my said friend Charles W Chapman Executor of this my last will & testament as aforesaid with full power to execute the same and release him from giving any bond and security
