aforesaid being Weak in body but of a sound  
Mind, do make and ordain this my last Will and testa-  
ment in manner and form following to wit:  
First, My desire is that all of my just debts be paid.  
Secondly, I leave unto my beloved Wife Anna Williamson  
the Plantation whereon I now live with all my kitchen and  
kitchenhold furniture, the stock of all kind Working Tools of  
every description and three Negroes viz Kitt & Fanny &  
Esther With their Increase during her Natural lifetime  
or Widowhood except a boy named already given to  
my son William Williamson, and also a boy named  
Cott already given to my son Amos Williamson.  
Thirdly, My desire is that my Wife and executor shall  
give to my Children such necessary goods & chattels as  
they deem necessary for them & my Children may  
claim of age or marry and keep necessary account  
of the same, and after the death of my Wife or marry  
sell my estate to be equally divided between all my  
Children, and I do appoint my Wife Anna Williamson  
and son William Williamson Executors and administrators of  
this my last Will and testament.
