In the name of God Amen  
I Daniel Scott of the County  
and State aforesaid being through the mercie of  
God spared until the present time though weak of  
body yet of sane and perfect mind and memory do  
make and ordain this my last Will and Testament  
Then first of all I recommend my soul into the hands  
of Almighty God that gave it and my body to be buried  
in a decent and Christian like manner

I give and bequeath unto my Wife Gemima  
Scott all my lands whereon I now live containing  
Six hundred and fifty acres more or less together with  
all household and kitchen furniture or as much as  
she may need with horses and stock of all kinds or  
a sufficiency to keep up the plantation With the  
following negroes (to wit) Austin, Hannah, Gey  
Nancy and her three children, Shup, Solomon  
and Quey. also one Road wagon and Ox and  
or cart. All the above named property I leave  
to her disposal so long as she remains my widow  
or keeps herself in good credit and standing  
otherwise she is to have nothing

If any of my children die leaving no law-  
fully heir or heirs then it is my desire that the prop-  
erty which they may receive from my Estate be return-  
ed and equally divided among the other Legates

It is my further Will and desire that those of  
my children that remain single be made equal  
with those that are married in portions & advances  
I further constitute my son Samuel Scott and he  
is hereby appointed the Trustee for my Daughter Jane  
Smith in who I desire the title of that portion of my  
Estate to rest, for the use and benefit of my Daughter  
Jane and her children (to wit) a child's part of  
what may now or hereafter be coming to her from my  
Estate I take this occasion to say that I have not  
so despised of my Daughter Jane's portion or account  
of a want of confidence in my son-in-law Elishe  
Smith but from the fact that Jane somewhat

I give and bequeath unto my son Daniel my  
 D. B. Shot gun and watch one and above the rest  
 all my property not disposed in this my Will  
 I wish to be equally divided among my seven  
 children (to wit) Jane (having special reference  
 to the above trusteeship) William, Samuel, Eliza-  
 -beth James, John and Daniel

At the death of my Wife, provided my Wife  
 remains single &c. it is my will that all the property  
 by which she may receive from my Estate to be equally  
 divided among my above named children.

I should any of my Legates attempt to cheat or  
 defraud the other out of their portions they  
 are to be excluded from any participation in my  
 Estate

I do hereby appoint my sons William and  
 Samuel my sole Executors of this my last Will  
 and Testament to attend to the settling of my busi-  
 ness accounts notes and judgements and to attend  
 to the educating of my youngest children and to the  
 enforcement of this Will
