 mind and knowing that I must shortly depart from this
 worlde deem it right & proper both as respects my self
 and my family that I should make a disposition of the
 property of with which it has pleased kind providence
 to bless me with I therefore make this my last Will &
 testament hereby revoking all and annulling all others
 heretofore made by me

Item 1st I give and devise to my beloved wife Rhody
 my negr woman Esther two feather beds bed stix & furni-
 tur her cows such as she may chose out of my entire stock of
 cattle one horse named Riley one large pine side board one
 large trunk and one large pine chest and one loom one
 cupboard one half dozen chairs 1 large wash pot 1 set
 fire dogs 1 dinner pot 2 coons 1 Skillet and one tea
 kettle 1 set pewter plates two tables one side saddle
 1 cart and young yoke of oxen also what farming
 utensils she may chose to carry on the farm also
 the Swarrigane lot of land containing two hundred & 24
 acres known & distinguished more defenately by the no one
 hundred & eighty one in the eleventh district originally
 Henry now Newton County also 2 Sows & pigs such as
 she may chose out of my stock of hogs also all the gear
 that is in my poppers 2 water pails 2 water piggins
 1 milk churn all the cockey ware & glass ware that
 is in my poppin also 6 year sheep such as she may
 chose out of my stock of sheep also 1 set silver spoons
 all of which shd is to have and hold in her own Right
 and for her own use during her nat. ear life or widowhood
 and in the event of her marriage the property to her
 join I desire and will that it then become the property
 of my children

My entire family of negroes (not including Estlin) I have with my beloved Rhoda subject to a division amongst my children at her discretion write time in the following manner viz

Item 3

With my son Edward in trust for his children free from all embarrassments of my son Edward I give my negro boy Sam who is now little seem to depart this life and in the event of his death if with the present sickness then I desire and will that his children have my negro boy Jerry

Item 4

I give and devise unto my beloved daughter Margaret Ann and her children by her present husband Anna David M Parker or any future husband free from the disposition of her present or future husband my negro boy named Franklin abt seven years old

Item 5

With my son Abel M Harper I give and bequeath my negro boy named Joel about five years old in trust for his children free from his own disposition also 1 cow & calf

Item 6

I give and devise unto my beloved daughter Sarah Ann and her children my negro boy Darius about three years old free from the disposition of her husband or in the event of her marriage also one cow & calf

Item 7

I desire that my Executor herein appointed shall sell and dispose of either by public or private sale for the purpose of paying all my just debts & sufficiency of my property that is to say lot of land no two hundred & five in the Eleventh district formerly Henrys new Newton County also one hundred acres joining

the aforesaid lot south being a part of lot number one hundred & eighty in said district also lot of land number two hundred & three in said district and all the rest of my property not mentioned in the foregoing Will

Item 8

I desire that at the division of my negroes among my children that the division be made according to valuation to be made by disinterested persons and if the boy Sam should live then my agreement to the provision of the first item of this will will be void and the proceeds of the sale be equally divided amongst my children in trust for these children also at the sale of my property I desire that any balance that may be over the payment of my debts be disposed of in the same way

Item 9

I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Rhoda Duntrey and my son Edward Harper and David M Parker Executors to this my last will & testament this seventh day of September one thousand eight hundred & forty six
