In the name of God Amen I Jane Rees of the County
of State aforesaid being of sound ~~mind and disposing~~ ^{mind} and disposing mind but weak in body and calling to
mind the uncertainty of life and being desirous to dispose
of my worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me
with do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament
in form following that is to say

I do The title of my two negroes namely Mary a boy
of Twelve years old Harriet a Girl of nine or ten years
old I give and vest in my Daughter now Mary McLaugh
of which she will have the entire use & benefit dur
ing her natural life and may use them in her own
personal possession in any way she may think proper
and not otherwise and at the death of Mary as aforesaid
all the right and title of or to Harriet as aforesaid
shall then vest in and pass to my Grand Daughter
Henny McLaugh to take possession of and use them own
and the right to & title of Mary I give
and vest in my Grandson Mr. Rees McLaugh at the
death of his mother Mary as aforesaid to take possession
and use to his own use and benefit, all this as I as
sure in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& seal this seventh day of October 1843 Brighten him
and I forty three in presence of
