

Georgia 21st of May 1835
Newton County 3 My last will and testament
I give unto my wife Matilda Segler, all
the lot or tract of lands on which we now
live, except fifty acres to be taken out of
the north West Corner, which lot of land
is known by lot No. 278, two hundred and
seventy eight, in the (16) sixteenth District of
Originally Henry now Newton County
also I give unto my wife Matilda Segler one
Bay Horse about four years of age, also
two Cows and calves, three four hammers
& two sows & pigs, I also give and
bequeath unto her all the household and
Kitchen furniture, except two beds which I
give unto my wife Matilda Segler
(Elizabeth and Angelica) I also give
and bequeath unto my sons Matthew &
John Nicholas, one hundred acres of land
to be equally divided between them, which
land is known by West half of lot
No. (289) two hundred and eighty nine in
the (16) sixteenth District of Originally
Henry now Newton County And I give and
bequeath unto my son William Riley, fifty
acres of land to be taken out of the
North West Corner of lot No. (278) Two
hundred and seventy eight, in the sixteenth
District of Originally Henry now Newton
County Now I wish such property and
effects as I have, and have not herein
disposed of to be sold & the produce
thereof to be put to the paying of debts,
the educating & supporting of my children
after which if there should be a
remainder I wish that to be equally
divided among my children
Now I do hereby appoint Matilda Segler
(my wife) Elijah Ragsdale Senr and R. W. Wood
Jr. as Executors to this my last will and
testament
