

In the name of God Amen I Margaret Buchanan of the County of Newton and State of Georgia being in a low state of health but of a sound mind and being persuaded of certainty of mortality and moved to make and ordain this my last Will and Testament which is as follows

1st Item My will and desire is that all my just debts shall be first paid

2nd Item I also give to Maryan Isabella Blake Daughter of the said Isabella Blake George a negro man and Milly a negro woman and Rocky a negro child and all my house hold and kitchen furniture also my wearing apparel and also one cow and calf and one sow and pigs the above the above named negroes George and Milly to go to the use of her the above named Isabella Blake during the lifetime of her the said Isabella Blake then to go to the use of the said Maryan Isabella Blake during her life time and then to her the said Maryan Isabella Blake's law full heirs

3rd Item I also give to William M. Blake a negro boy by the name of Joe by his the said William M. Blake's making an equal division of the value of said negro Joe among the rest of his brothers and his sister Jane Bell Blake

4th Item I do hereby give all my property which is not given in the above and foregoing Items to be equally divided between William M. Blake and his brothers and his sister Jane Bell

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 19th day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty six. The foregoing Will signed sealed and acknowledged in presence of us
