 Henry a boy Phany a Girl and Waven a boy and
 keep them untill the hire of the three negroes will
 amount to and pay off all my just debt after
 wards dispose of as herein after directed

Item the 4th I give and bequeath to my son in
 law John C. Stearns Henry a boy with all the
 right in any manner pertaining there

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my son Euell
 Miller my negro boy Waven with all the right per-
 taining in any manner whatsoever forever

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my son Robert
 D. Miller my negro girl Phany with all the right
 appertaining in any manner whatsoever forever

I then the 7th I hereby constitute and appoint my
worthy friends Peter Humble and William Sherrill
Executors of this my last Will and Testament this
March the 18th 1849
