 that it is appointed unto all ~~men~~ once to die. do make
 and ordain this my last will and testament that is to
 say first and principally above all I give and recom-
 mend my soul into the hands of God that gave it and my
 body to the earth to be buried I recommend to the earth
 to be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner
 of the disposition of my relations nothing doubting but
 I shall receive it again at the general resurrection by
 the mighty power of God and as touching such world-
 ly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me
 with in this life I give demise and dispose of in the
 following manner.

I desire and request that all my just debts be
 paid by my Executors early as possible after my
 decease. The remainder of my estate viz one negro
 boy by the name of Andy one by the name of Ran-
 dol one by the name of Isaac. one negro girl by
 the name of Caroline and one by the name of Ha-
 seline and their increase, together with my stock
 corn and fodder household and kitchen furni-
 -ture and all other property, thing or things what-
 -soever may belong to me at the time of my decease I
 give and bequeath to my son-in-law William Warren
 my son-in-law Littleton. Naming my son-in-law
 Isaac W. D. Dehan on my son-in-law Amos Vincent
 my son George W. Hamilton and the heirs of my
 son Cassie Hamilton deceased to wit John W. Hay-
 -ash N. Julia Ann L. Mary R. Robert L. George L.
 and Martha I to be equally divided among said
 Legatus except the seven heirs of my son Cassie
 as above named who shall have their share and

Jointly one portion of my estate being a sixth part
 I do make them together equal to one of the other
 Legatus in the division of my property - and in the
 event that the said Legatus cannot agree in the
 division of the property - It is my desire in that
 case that the property be disposed of at the dis-
 cretion of my executor in a lawful manner so
 as to effect an equal division among said Legatus
 as aforesaid

I now constitute and appoint my son George
 K Hamilton of the County of DeKalb and my
 son in law Leighton Manning of the County of
 Newton and said State my Executors of this my
 last Will and Testament and I do hereby disallow
 revoke and disannul all and every former Will and
 Testament or bequest, legacies and executor by me
 heretofore made ratifying and confirming this to be
 my last Will and Testament
