Thomas Fretwell a Negro boy slave named
John

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my son
Leonard Fretwell in trust for my Granddaughter
Lucy, Elsie, El Brown Fretwell and the Heirs of
his body a negro Woman slave named Eliza
and her increase

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my son
Leonard Fretwell in trust for my Granddaughter
Frances Cannon Wife of N. L. Peterson and the Heirs
of her body a negro Woman slave named Sarah
and her increase

Fifthly I give and bequeath to my son Leonard
Fretwell in trust for my Granddaughter Nancy
Fretwell and the Heirs of her body a negro boy
slave named George

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my son
Leonard Fretwell in trust for my Granddaughter
Elizabeth Fretwell and the Heirs of
her body a negro boy slave named Robert

Seventhly I give and bequeath to my Grandson
William A. Fretwell son of Leonard Fretwell
a negro boy slave named Charles

Eighthly I give and bequeath to my Grandson Philip
Fretwell son of Leonard Fretwell a negro boy slave
named Judge

Ninthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter in law
Polly Fretwell wife of my son Leonard Fretwell a negro
Girl slave named Caroline to have and possess during
her natural life and at her death it is my will
and I desire that she shall have the privilege of
designating or appointing to which one or more of my
Grandchildren the Heirs of her body said negro
Caroline and her issue shall ascend

Tenthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Lucy & Sister Nancy Dunge and Peter Harwell
each the sum of Five dollars having long since given
to them and into their possession and enjoyment what
I consider their and each of their full proportion
and share of all my worldly effects

Eleventh I give and bequeath to my son Leonard
Fretwell and deliver into his possession and full enjoy-
ment the following described negro slaves (to wit)
a negro fellow named Bill, a negro fellow named
Keptum a negro boy named Tom a negro woman
named Milly a negro Woman named Emily and
a negro boy child named Sampson

Twelfth I do hereby appoint my son Leonard
Fretwell and my Grandson Richard Fretwell my
Executors to carry into effect this my last Will and
Testament

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my seal this the 16th day of August
in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
and a fully love
