of the County and State aforesaid being of sound
and disposing mind and memory but in feeble health and mindful
of the uncertain duration of life - do make and ordain this to be my
last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills

Item first. I wish all my just debts paid so soon as they can
conveniently be out of the first money collected belonging to my
estate

Item second I give and bequeath unto my lovely Daughter
Mary Louisa Casam Sampson the sum of twenty dollars in ad-
dition to what she has already received.

Item third I give and bequeath unto my son William J
Wright in trust and for the use and benefit of my son
or sons and I Wright the sum of Two hundred dollars with
the privilege to the said trustee to advance to the said Legson
I Wright the whole or any part of said sum, as he may deem
proper for his greater comfort.

Item fourth I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Frances Ann Rebecca Galloway and her children free from
the disposition of her present or any future husband a negro
boy named Arnold about eighteen years old and a negro girl
named Celestia about eleven years old with the understanding
that if my son William J Wright so desire he is to have the
said boy Arnold at his appraised value, and the money to be
paid out by my Executor in purchasing another negro which
purchase a negro is to take the place of the said boy Arnold.

It is further my Will that the property given in this item re-
spect on the failure of issue of the said Frances Ann Rebecca
Galloway to my son William J Wright

Item fifth I give and bequeath all the remainder and residue
of my property both real and personal of all kinds to my son
William J Wright

Item sixth I hereby constitute and appoint my son William
J Wright sole executor of this my last Will and Testament.
