

The last will & Testament of William Gohier son.

In the name of God Amen I will Gohier of
the State of Georgia and County of Newton being
a weak body but of perfect mind and memory
thanks be to God amply calling into mind the
mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed
for all men to die I do make & ordain that my
last will and testament that is to say touching
my worldly estate when with it hath pleased God to
bless me in this life I give and dispose of the same
in the following manner

First. I give and bequeath
unto my dear wife Lucy Gohier all my estate
both real and personal during her natural life.
Secondly I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Sarah Hodge a negro boy by the name of Platan
Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Mary Blackston a negro boy by the name of
Samuel

Fourth I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah
Giles a negro boy by the name of Robert and I
also give unto her at the present time or at the death
One feather bed and furniture.

Fifth I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy
Giles a negro boy by the name of Gabriel Also I now
give unto her or some time at my death two feather
beds & furniture.

Sixth I give and bequeath unto my
Daughter Rody Blackwell a negro girl by the name
of Catharine. Seventh I give and bequeath unto
my son Reley Giles two negro girls by the names
of Elizabeth and Abby and the land on which it now
lives and I also give him my wagon and team
but if the horses die or the wagon be destroyed or
worn out before the division of my estate which is
to take place at the death of my wife my estate
is not to make them good to him and I also give
unto him now or at my death one feather bed
and furniture.

Eighth I give and bequeath unto
my son William Giles Five dollars.

Ninth I give and bequeath unto the heir of my son
Emasiah Giles Five dollars.

Tenth I give and bequeath unto my son John
Giles Five dollars.

Eleventh I give and bequeath
unto my son George Giles Five dollars.

Twelfth I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Clary Taylor Five dollars.

Thirteenth I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Abby Mitchell Five dollars.

Fourteenth I give and bequeath unto my son
James G. H. Five dollars.

Fifteenth I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Elizabeth H. Five dollars.

Sixteenth I give and bequeath unto my son Daniel
Giles five dollars.

Seventeenth I give and bequeath unto my son Richd
Giles Five dollars.

Eighteenth I give and bequeath unto my son
Levi H. Five dollars.

I have a lot of land lying in the County of Hamilton
is sold at my death I hereby authorize my executors
to sell it when it can be done at a reasonable price
and divide the price as I have directed the remainder
of my estate

So I constitute appointing and choosing
Facy Goble my wife and Riley Goble my son
my sole executors of this my last will and testa-
ment and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and
disannul and every other former testament with
Lynacus Bequiths Executors by me in any wise
before named Willers and bequeath that nothing and
confirms this and no other this my last will
and testament.
