Newton County, Ga In the name of God amew I William

Heath of the County aforesaid a free man
being weak in body but of sound disposing mind & memory
(before he goes) do hereby make & publish this my last
will and testament in manner & form following (viz)

Item 1st I wish my body to be buried in a plain decent
manner

Item 2nd I wish all my just debts paid by my executors

Item 3rd I will and give unto my son in law William
B Allen a certain negro girl named Elomira estimated
at four hundred and fifty dollars which has been already
in his possession

Item 4th I will and give unto my son Erasmo Heath
a certain negro boy named Berrell estimated at four
hundred and fifty dollars which he has already in his pos-
session

Item 5th I will & give unto my son Erasmus Heath a
certain negro girl named Easter estimated at four hun-
dred and fifty dollars which he has already in his pos-
session

Item 6th I will & give unto my son Openetis Heath a
certain negro boy named Boston estimated at four hundred
and fifty dollars

Item 7th I will & give unto my son William Heath
four hundred dollars which I have already paid him

Item 8th I will & give unto my son Henry Heath
a certain negro boy named Colquitt estimated at four
hundred dollars which he has already in his possession

Item 9th I will & give unto my son John Heath a cer-
tain negro boy named Dick estimated at four hundred
and twenty five dollars which he has already in his possession

Item 10th I will & give unto my daughter Mary Caroline Samp a
certain negro girl named Maria estimated at three hundred and
fifty dollars which she has already in possession

Item 11th I will and bequeath unto my daughter Rosetta Rebecca
Dugay a certain negro girl named Amy estimated at five hun-
dred dollars which she has already in possession under a care of
trust

Item 12th I will and bequeath unto my son Openetis Heath in
trust for my daughter Sarah Jane Turner a certain negro girl
named Narcissus estimated at three hundred dollars which said
negro girl & her increase it is my will shoulde be equally di-
vided between her husband John A Turner & the balance of my
legatees if the said Sarah Jane Turner shoulde die without issue

Item 13th I will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary
Heath in trust for my two daughters Susan Frances & Isabella
Heath two certain negroes to be paid out of my estate to them
whenever they arrive of age or marries which said negroes &
their increase it is my will shall revert to my estate again
if they the said Susan Frances & Isabella dies without issue
the said negroes to be estimated at four hundred & fifty
dollars apiece

Item 14th It is my will and desire that my executors pay
over to my legatees mentioned in the foregoing items so
much money as will make each of their proportions an
amount to four hundred and fifty dollars out of the
money made on my farm or so soon as it can be made
after paying my just debts & support of my family

Item 15th I will and bequeath unto beloved wife Mary
Heath during her natural life the following named
negroes & their increase (with the exception of the two
which are to be paid my daughters Frances & Isabella which
are included in this item) Dick Slavy, Sam Gamory,
Sarah, Isabella, Melinda, Zena, Joseph, Leah, Walter
Henry together with my plantation wherein I now live

with all my Stock of Horses, Cattle hogs sheep, Corn
for seed & all the plantation tools with all my house-hold
Kitchen furniture

Item 16th It is my will I desire that after the death of
my beloved wife that my estate which may be left at
her death shall be equally divided between my said legatees
share and share alike and that portion of it which may
be going to Emily Allen, I will and bequeath to my son
Epenetus Heath in trust for my said daughter Emily Allen
and the heirs of her body which may be of the female
sex and that portion of it which may be going to Harriet
Rebecca Plaza I will and bequeath to my son Epenetus
Heath in trust for my said daughter Harriet Rebecca
and the heirs of her body & if the said Harriet Rebecca
dies without issue then the same to be equally division
among the residue of my legatees under the same re-
strictions as I have set forth in the 12th Item of this
instrument and that portion of it which may be go-
ing to Sarah Jane Turner to be under the same restric-
tion as the said 13th Item of this instrument, and that
portion of it which may be going to Susan Francis &
Addell I will & bequeath to my son Epenetus Heath
in trust for the said Susan Francis & Addell under
the like restrictions as are set forth in the 13th Item of
this instrument.

I hereby nominate & do hereby constitute and appoint my
beloved friend William Evans and my beloved wife
Mary Heath Executor and Executrix of this my last
will and testament hereby revoking and setting aside
all others wills & testaments by me heretofore made
I'm writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 5th day of February 1845

Newton County, Pennsylvania came into open Court Augustus M
Evans Francis M. Nix and Dawson Nix who

executed the same freely without compulsion so far as we
know and that we sign the same as witnesses in the pres-
