and perfect memory so after consulting my body to
the Lord and myself to God will give be wish to
dispose of my estate in the following manner

I do hereby give and bequeath to my Wife Eliza
William Daniel my wife's share One negro Woman
by the name of Julia and her child by the name
of Mary one brown pony man and saddle one cow and
saddle one pig and so much of my household &
belongings as she shall think fit for her use
and disposing some of the rest of land where I now live which
is to be used of in the following manner do as to include the
spring and house, also my personal effects and furniture
my share to list the balance of my land and stock of all
kinds I leave to her and apply to the payment of my
debts, and I reserve one share to my self after pay-
ing my debts it should be divided amongst my children
first share here after to be made and after the death of my
Wife Eliza Daniel my share is list and myself to give
to her and all other property not herein named that
belongs to me should be sold and the money arising
from the sale should be divided among all my children
as follows as my share is list all my children should
have a like share I give one seventh part of my estate
to the care of my son William D. Daniel with the ex-
ception of fifty dollar which he has now received
above the rest of my children and I give one seventh
part to my Daughter Mary I give one seventh part to
my Daughter Nancy Milton one seventh part to my
seventh part to my son William D. Daniel with the
exception of twenty three dollars which he has now

all money above the rest of my children I give one seventh part
to my Daughter Sarah Stallings I give one seventh part to
my Daughter Elizabeth I give one seventh part to my son
Dr. Eliza Davis lastly I bequeath and appoint Thomas Jones
and Isaac D. Stallings my lawful executors to execute this my
last Will and Testament
