and preserve from waste or loss all the perishable property of
the said deceased and shall make or cause to be made a true
& correct Inventory of all such Estate and the same being
assessed as such and up such Estate & goods with the
Inventory aforesaid into the legal & proper Administrator
or Executor when required by law with all their duties
& doings therein faithfully perform the same & pay the same
then this obligation to be null & void & the same
shall remain in full force & virtue
