for value he might as it can be paid and if they cannot
agree last life for the highest Bidder the first three are
the Part of Land up in Appearances that I bought of John
Wells for the fourth share this Land is value of one thousand
dollars and the Part of Land on a value of three thousand
dollars for four of my sons and the other two to have a
thousand dollars each of to live out of the movable property
and the Revenue and if any life to be divided Equally among
them all I give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth all
my Negro Woman Catharine whether during her continuance or life
time and a comfortable living out of the Estate and for the
Negro woman Catharine in the Service of the son that has no name
except this is a gift of sufficient that creates an thousand dollars
worthmore than to be Equally divided amongst the whole of
the children or the value of her life and movable share which
to live with if they can pay for her I want my son Samuel to
be kept in the family if possible or excluded to share with
children former except they all agree to sell it over or the
Executor go to the age of twenty five years any of my two wants
to keep the Land that I want to be sold or there be no body
else until that time is expired that the youngest son is twenty
five years old and I satisfy this of my last Will
