advanced age and knowing that I must shortly
depart this life do now it right and proper both as
respects my family and myself that I should make a
disposition of the property with which a kind Providence
has blessed me do therefore make this my last Will and Testament

1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a
decent and Christian like manner suitable to my
Circumstances and Condition in life my soul I trust
shall return to rest with God who gave it - and
I hope for Eternal Salvation through the merits and
Atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus
Christ whose religion I have professed and do
humbly trust enjoyed for these years

2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my Executors herein after appointed
as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed
in their rights especially as there is no benefit for delay

3rd I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sarah
Ellis my beloved daughter Mary D Robertson and
my beloved Son Robert Hammel all of my property both
real and personal during their natural life and
to their children forever

I desire and direct that should the aforesaid
Mary D Robertson depart this life without children
I give and bequeath all her interest in my estate to the
children of Sarah Ellis and the children of Robert
Hammel after the estate of the aforesaid Mary D
Robertson is over for ever

Robert Hammel Executor of this my last Will and Testament
