I, Ellice Cochran, do hereby certify that I am a Christian and believing that I must shortly depart from this world I deem it right and proper both as respects myself and my family that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind providence has blessed me I therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all others heretofore made by me

Item

I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to the circumstances and conditions My soul I trust shall return to rest with those who have gone on as I hope for eternal salvation through the blessing of God and Saviour Jesus Christ

Item Second

I Give and devise to my beloved wife Nancy with whom I have lived in the strictest quiet and love Lots of land No Seven Hundred and forty 340, Seven Hundred and seventy three 733, Eight Hundred and ~~eighty~~ 813, North half of lot No Eight Hundred and twelve 812, West half of lot No Seven Hundred and forty one 741, West half of Seven Hundred and seventy two 772, all in the Second District Third Section of Paulding County Containing in all one Hundred and eighty acres with all the rights and appurtenances to said lots of land in any wise belonging During her natural life or widowhood I also bequeath to my wife in the same manner farming utensils used on and belonging to said plantation of every description and four head of Horses and mules and eight head of Cattle and seventeen head of Hogs all of my house hold and kitchen furniture belonging to said plantation

Item Third

I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife for and during her natural life or widowhood my two Horse Wagon and Buggy

Item Fourth

I Constitute and appoint my son William A Cochran & Melford Webb Executors to this my last Will and Testament this July 13th 1868 Alexander Cochran (S)
