Rents of the Paulding County Wills and Estates
being in usual health of Body & sound in mind and memory because that it is appointed unto all men once to die and being is best both in regard to myself And my Dear Wife and Children that I should make a disposition of the property that a Kind Providence hath committed to my trust I do hereby make this my last Will and Testament in form And form following to wit Item 1st It is my Will that my Body be decently committed to the dust from which I originally sprang Hoping that my Soul will rest with God through the merits of an all sufficient and Glorious Redeemer Item 2nd I wish all my just debts to be paid as soon as possible without distress to my wife and Children and at the death of my Executors here in after named Item 3rd I Give and bequeath at my death unto my Dear Wife all the property both real and personal that came to her from her Father J. Chapman Estate and that the said property to be at her disposal Item 4th I also will and bequeath unto my Wife Mary all that plantation or tract of land I own in Paulding County and State of Georgia Containing one hundred Twenty Acres to have and to hold During her natural life of her death to go to my child Mary or her heirs Item 5th All the Balance of my property to be equally divided between my Children viz John & Mary and their heirs Mary - Sarah Julia and John & their heirs

 by him And I do hereby nominate and appoint as my executor
 John St. Edwards and I hope they will carry out
 and legally the Testamentary which I have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my seal this 9th day of June
 1861
