- 3^d I desire and will as my Children become of age or
marry that my wife give to them such of my
property as she may think proper and right
- 4th I will that the property which my wife claims at
her death shall return to my Children and be
equally divided between them
- 5th Should my wife need any help in the management
of my estate I want her to get the advice and counsel
of such Friends as she can depend upon and allow
for her to have the right with the advice of such
Friends to sell all or any part of my property as she
may think proper and right
- 6th I nominate and appoint my beloved wife Mrs
Elizabeth Still executrix of my Estate
