Item 2 I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth all my property of every description both real and personal to be at her disposal during her life and at the death of the said Elizabeth my Wife, if any thing left I desire that the same be equally divided among all my children to wit my daughter Nancy Nichols wife of William Nichols Sarah P Holland wife of Archibald Holland Benjamin F Elbert James F Elbert Aaron Spinks wife of William P Spinks Nathan S Durham wife of W M S Durham Saba M Holland wife of William E Holland Zebulon B Elbert Joseph C Elbert Samuel E and Lindsey W Elbert children of Matthew M Elbert deceased Grace Catharine and George I and Mary Elbert children of Lindsey W Elbert deceased I desire that the above named children of Matthew M Elbert and Lindsey W Elbert have the share their father would have been entitled to had they have lived I bequeath to George F Elbert an equal share with my other children above named should any thing be left at the death of my beloved Wife the said Elizabeth Elbert

Item 3rd I desire that my Executors hereafter appointed dispose of such property as can not be spared for the purpose of paying all my just debts with a little delay as possible

Item 4 I hereby appoint my son Benjamin F Elbert and my son in law William E Holland my Executors of this my last Will and Testament
