 First I give and bequeath my soul to God and my body to
 God from whence I came I also I will and Bequeath to
 Thomas Mullins my eldest son all of my property consisting
 as follows my Negro Woman Sarahs who I bought my Negro
 Boy also all of my house hold furniture consisting of two
 chests Bed and clothing and two Bedsteads with
 furniture and two plow Bars and my flock of Cattle and
 Sheep the D^r and known of other my small Waggon and
 Gear and plows and plow gear I also bequeath the above
 named property to the said son to have and dispose of the above
 named Thomas Mullins during his natural life and of any
 gift to be equally divided among my other children to wit
 my daughter Nancy Mullins my daughter Mary Mullins

also Elias Ashtown Perry, Clement Rucker & Samuel Myers
 and Mahalia Hickman my Daughter which is my Wife and I have
 had the above Names. Now Children to Wm. Thomas & Children my
 Daughter Nancy. These my Daughter Elias Mullins Ashtown Mullins
 Perry Mullins & Clement Mullins Rucker Mullins & Samuel Mullins also
 Mahalia Hickman my Daughter this is my Son I also Wm. and
 Benjamin to Ashtown Mullins & Son but my Son and my Son
 which is now in possession of Ashtown Mullins my Son
 this is my last Will and Testament In Witness Whereof I the
 said Benjamin Mullins have to this my last Will and Testament
 I have set my hand and seal this day year above written.
