I Will that all my Just Ditties be paid

I leave to Thomas B W M Wicklin the Sum of Three Dollars

I leave to Hugh Greer the Sum of Three Dollars

I leave to Spencer Greer the Sum of Three Dollars

I leave to Robert Greer the Sum of Three Dollars

I leave all the balance of my Estate to my Sister Jane Wright and the heirs of her Body

I do nominate and appoint Robert M Bryant my Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 4th of Oct 1860
