

Will of Miss Kate T. Wommack

State of Georgia-Houston County.

In the name of God, Amen.

I, Kate T. Wommack, of said State and County, and being of sound and disposing mind and memory, make declare and publish this as my last will and testament, hereby revoking and annulling all wills or codicils to the same at any time heretofore made by me.

Item First.

I desire my body to be buried in decent and Christianlike manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life, and all of my debts, should I leave any at the time of my death, paid, as little delay as possible.

Item Second.

I will, bequeath and devise to J.L. Watson of Bibb County Georgia and B.H. Watson of Houston County Georgia, all of the property, real, personal and mixed and choses in action of every description of which I may die seized and possessed, share and share alike. I give them all of said property for the reason of their uniform kindness and financial assistance to me for many years.

Item Third.

I nominate and appoint J.L. Watson, of Bibb County Georgia the executor of this my last will and testament, without his giving any bond, as such, and relieve him from making any inventory or return of his actings and do as such, to any court or authority. I give him full authority to sell any or all of my property, real or personal, either at public or private sale and any order of court first had therefor; either to pay my debts or for distribution or otherwise.
