

Will of Sarah Jane Walton

Georgia, Peach County.

I, Sarah Jane Walton of said state and county being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last will and testament.

1. I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and christian like manner.
2. I give, bequeath and devise to my daughter Jessie Walton Pitts all of my personal property including the cash money on hand at my death, chickens and cow, except that I desire my household furniture to be equally divided between my two daughters Jessie Walton Pitts and Lethe Walton Anderson.
3. I desire that my real estate in the town of Byron, which consists of about three and one-third acres of land adjoining the Farmers Bank lot be sold and the proceeds of the sale be disposed of as follows: first that twelve hundred and fifty dollars and interest thereon, if any interest be due at my death be paid my daughters Jessie Walton Pitts and Lethe Walton Anderson to settle a debt which I am due them, then the next \$400.00 from the sale of this property be spent on my cemetery lot in providing slabs for the graves of my self and husband.
4. I desire that after the payment of the debt due my daughters and paying for slabs for the graves, that the next \$400.00 derived from the sale of the Byron Property be equally divided between my son Gardner K. Walton and my two daughters Lethe Walton Anderson and Jessie Walton Pitts and after the payment of the above legacy, I desire that whatever money remains from the sale of this property be equally divided between my four children to wit: James M. Walton, Gardner K. Walton, Lethe Walton Anderson and Kessie Walton Pitts.
5. I hereby appoint my daughter Lethe Walton Anderson executrix of this my last will and testament and it is my desire that she be not required to make returns of her acts and doings as executrix to any court. It is my desire that my executrix sell my real estate either at public or private sale as she in her judgement deems to be the best interest of my estate and not to sell it until she thinks it will bring a fair price.
