ITEM I.

ITEM II.

I desire and direct that all of my just debts, if any there be, be paid as promptly as possible by my Executrix hereinafter named.

ITEM III.

I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Katie E. Sheats, all of the property, both real and personal, of any and every kind and character, including notes, accounts, choses in action, of which I may die seized and possessed, to be hers absolutely and without any sort of restriction or limitation whatsoever. I make bequest of all of my property thus exclusive-ly to my said wife for the reason that I am confident that she will provide and care for our beloved children with the same thought and impartiality as I would myself; and I desire that she be free to have, use, and enjoy whatever estate I may possess at the time of my death to the best advantage and without handicap or restriction.

ITEM IV.

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said wife, Katie E. Sheats, as sole Executrix of this my will; and I especially desire and direct that she be not required to give any bond for the faithful performance of her duties as such executrix to any Court or Courts and that she be not required to make any inventory, appraisement or return or any report of any nature or character whatsoever of her actings and doings as such Executrix.
