

WILL OF LAURA I. JONES.

State of Georgia-Peach County.

In the name of God, Amen; I Laura I. Jones, of said state and county, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make, declare and publish this as my last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all wills or codicils to the same at any time heretofore made by me.

Item First:

I desire my body buried in a decent and Christianlike manner, suitable to my condition and circumstances in life, I desire a granite slab or marble slab to be placed over my grave.

Item Second:

I give and bequeath and devise to my father, W. C. Carter, that certain promissory note the principal sum of Two Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, together with all coupon interest attached, made by T. R. Ousley to Glenmore Green on the 8th day of November 1923 and due on the 8th day of November 1928, and by said Glenmore Green transferred to me; also the debt of \$2,000.00 and interest. Said deed recorded on November 20th 1923 in Book No. 2407 in the Clerk's office of Houston Superior Court. Said deed with all rights and title the same and to the lands secured thereby having been transferred and assigned to me by Glenmore Green on the 8th day of November 1923.

Item Third:

I give, bequeath and devise all of the residue of my property, real and personal and wherever located, to my beloved daughter, Annie Elizabeth Jones, and I hereby constitute and appoint my sister, Mrs. Agnes Carter Brunson, testamentary guardian of all of the property left to my said daughter in Item Third of this will; I also give to my said sister the custody and control of my said daughter, believing that she will have the same love and care for her as I would have.

Item Fourth:

I nominate and appoint H. G. Brunson, the executor of this my last will and testament, relieving him from making any inventory of my estate and from making annual returns of his doings in the premises; Should it be necessary to raise money to pay my debts that I may owe at my death, I empower him to hypothecate any of the securities I may leave, and to transfer and assign any deeds to secure debt and the property described therein, in order to raise said funds, either at public or private sale or negotiation and without any aid of court.
